

President's Message








Out of respect for all of our members, if someone is sick in your household with a cold, flu OR Covid, please refrain from coming to the Centre.


Germs spread easily and we all need to do our part to stop the spread.

Perogies


At the March Perogy bee we made approximately 70 dozen perogies.

360 degrees (3+6+0 = 9) 180 degrees (1+8+0 =9) 90 degrees (9+0 =9) 45 degrees (4+5=9)

All of our exercises that we do in Tai Chi class are performed in multiples of 9. The number 9 represents patience and harmony. The qualities of 9 include friendship, spirituality, unity, and the ability to see things clearly.






